## Northampton County Intercounty Transfer Information

- No ARD cases.
- > Six months or more of supervision required, regardless of charge and/or risk assessment level.
- ➤ Low risk assessments are not accepted, unless overridden by sending county based on proper override criteria. Northampton County will perform an ORAS Risk Assessment using the CSST, CST, MST, or MAT tool(s). If the risk assessment is lower than an assessment provided, the sending county will be notified of potential placement on call in status (AP Pro-Track).
- No cases with outstanding warrants.
- \$30.00 per month supervision fee.
- EM/HA/GPS/CAM: All EM/HA cases are handled by GPS. Fee is \$10.00/day; lump sum payment is required up front for the initial six months (or less). Per Northampton County Court policy, sex offenders who are registered and/or have committed a "hands on" offense are placed on GPS supervision for their entire length of supervision.
