Question: (from Cambria County)

Is there any county that has a reentry coordinator for specialty courts (i.e drug court, vet court, mental health court)?

Allegheny County

Allegheny County has a problem-solving court coordinator who oversees our seven problem solving courts. Each of the seven also have individual probation supervisors and dedicated POs within the unit.

The Allegheny County Jail has a reentry unit/coordinator, and they work closely with our Adult Probation Reentry Unit that is comprised of a supervisor and five POs.

Berks County

Cumberland County has a staff member that serves as our reentry coordinator. She attends to clients in the specialty courts as well as any other client under supervision. She also serves on the executive committee of the county reentry coalition. As a reentrant herself, she provides excellent insight.

We have the Lancaster County Re-entry Coalition that serves all returning citizens. It is not specific to our three treatment Courts (Drug, Mental Health, Veterans).
