Issue: Aggressive dog restrictions

Question (from Tioga County)

Do any counties have any language in their rules specific to aggressive dog restrictions?

Adams County

No restrictions; nothing in our rules. We have a notification in our database indicating they have an aggressive animal.

Allegheny County

No restrictions. Nothing in our rules in Allegheny. We do have a notification in red in our database next to the address indicating that they have an aggressive animal. It is up to the PO to keep the information current.

Bucks County

Nothing in our rules, it's part of the intake process and we put an alert in our RMS that will print out on the face sheet that goes to the assigned PO.

Carbon County

Same as Allegheny

Elk County

Elk puts a note in red in our case management system to alert POs. It's up to the POs to keep information up to date and accurate.

Erie County

Erie does not. Something to think about

Franklin County

Our intake packet asks if there are aggressive animals in the home. We also use an alert box in our CMS.

Jefferson County

No specific condition in our rules, but an alert is submitted in AP

Juniata County

Nothing in our conditions, just a note in AP

Lackawanna County

Nothing in our conditions, noted in system as an alert

Lebanon County

Does not

Lehigh County

We do not. However, our use of force model dictates how we can respond. There's nothing in our rules.

Luzerne County

Not addressed in rules – AP alert. Will revisit

Philadelphia County

Does not. An alert in case management system is noted.

Pike County

Nothing in our conditions, just a note in AP

Westmoreland County

Does not. An alert in case management system is noted.

Wayne County

Wayne posts an alert button in UCM.

York County

York does not. Similar to Franklin, we ask and enter an alert in our case management system.
