- No ARD cases.
- No cases with 6 months of supervision or less, regardless of charge and/or risk assessment, unless Northampton Co. already has an active case.
- Low risk assessments are not accepted, unless overridden by sending county based on proper override criteria. Northampton County will perform an ORAS Risk Assessment using the CSST, CST, MST, or MAT tool(s). If the risk assessment is lower than an assessment provided, the sending county will be notified of potential placement on call in status (AP Pro-Track).
- No cases with outstanding criminal warrants. EXCEPTIONS:
 - The defendant is attempting to address the warrant(s).
 - The warrant(s) are more than 10 years old.
 - The warrant(s) are non-criminal, traffic or summary offenses.
- \$30.00 per month supervision fee.
- EM/HA/GPS/CAM: All EM/HA cases are handled by GPS. Fee is \$10.00/day; lump sum payment is required up front for the initial six months (or less depending on specific income situation).
